



C. Ped (C) Examination
Courses for New UWO Requirement

As stated last year, beginning January 1, 2011 all applicants for the Certified Pedorthist (Canada) examination will now be required to have two additional core competency courses: one in orthotic fabrication and one in footwear modification. **The fall 2010 sitting will be the last opportunity to qualify for the C. Ped (C) examination without this new requirement. Anyone applying for the spring 2011 exam sitting will be required to have proof of completion for these two courses, or they will not be allowed to challenge the examination.**

These two required courses are available online through the University of Western Ontario's Continuing Studies department. You must be a member of the Pedorthic Association of Canada (PAC) in order to be eligible to take this course.

As these two courses are usually only available in January to March, UWO has added two additional slots for the required courses to accommodate candidate members who wish to attempt the examination for the spring 2011 sitting:

PEDS 6013: Pedorthic Approach to Footwear and Footwear Modification

September 7, 2010-November 26, 2010

Cost: \$550.00

Registration deadline: August 6, 2010

PEDS 6012: Advanced Orthotic Systems

November 22, 2010-December 3, 2010

Cost: \$550.00

Registration deadline: October 22, 2010

Payment must be provided at time of registration and can be made by cheque or credit card (Visa, M/C or AMEX).
